

COOKIES POLICY

1. Cookies Policy

Last Lap, a company founded in Spain, established in c/ La Granja, 22, 28100, Alcobendas, Madrid, is responsible and administrator for the website sansilvestrevallecana.com (hereinafter, the “Website”), it uses cookies for the purpose of enhancing the user experience on the Website. Cookies are used to improve this web browsing (e.g. remembering the language selected and other specific settings), or even to become necessary to provide in an appropriate and legal manner those services you may request (e.g. remembering the selected settings for cookies). Moreover, some cookies provide statistical data on the use of the Website to Last Lap, that indirectly facilitates the adaptation to your preferences. Cookies may also allow you to use some additional functions included on the Website (e.g. Applications available through the Website).

WHAT EXACTLY ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are sent to your computer by a web server and allow us to know how often you visit our Website and the activities you conduct while on our Website. They include a unique identifier which allow us to distinguish your device from the rest, but they do not collect any personal information.

Thanks to the cookies, Last Lap is able to make sure that the information appearing on this Website during the next visit is accurate and suited to your preferences. Cookies help Last Lap to identify which areas are popular on the Website, because they allow us to know which pages people visit on our Website and how much time is spent on each page. Based on this data, Last Lap can redesign its Website to better meet the needs of the visitors and optimize the visitor experience. Finally, cookies can make use of certain third party applications, as happens with the social networking links.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

Our Website uses two types of cookies: “session cookies” and “persistent cookies”. Session cookies exist only for the length of time you visit our site and are deleted once you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies remain stored on your browser ready for use the next time you visit our website.

With respect to the origin, cookies can be divided into “first party cookies” and “third party cookies”. First party cookies are set by us on the Website to enable the normal navigation on the Website, to enhance its functioning or to meet legal requirements. Third party cookies come from third party websites already chosen to support several functions of the Website.

1.1. The following table summarizes the cookies functional categories we may use.

Types of cookies	What are they used for?	How do they affect privacy?
Necessary	<p>These are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you the web browsing, and the storage of all necessary information to fill in the form.</p>	<p>These cookies work automatically during the browsing session or during longer periods of time, according to their purpose. Since they are necessary for the normal navigation on the Website or for the compliance of legal requirements, you may not disable them. Additional information on this issue may be found in Section 1.7 of the present policy. In any case, if the user does not wish these cookies to be installed, he has the option of leaving the Website at any time.</p>
Functionality	<p>These cookies register the selections made in some areas of the Website, where personal data is given (the user's name, the language or the region in which he is located). They also can be used to remember the changes he makes (e.g. In the font or the text size, or in other elements on the Website that can be customized), the pages he visited during the web browsing or the fact that he has previously visited the Website.</p>	<p>The information collected by these cookies may be technical information, concerned in view of the visit and associated to the device (no personal data will be collected)</p> <p>If desired, users can refuse its consent or disable the cookies from the corresponding menu on their browser; nevertheless, this may affect the browsing experience on the Website.</p> <p>Sometimes, these cookies can be configured to collect personally identifiable information the user has revealed, like the user's name or the profile image.</p> <p>When the user communicates these personal data, he will be asked to provide consent or, at least, he will be informed about our privacy practices. If he decides he wants to communicate its details and request some services, these cookies will be necessary in order to provide them.</p>
Analytical	<p>These are those that are well treated by third parties, (e.g. Google Analytics) and they help website owners to understand how their visitors engage with their website (e.g. To identify from where visitors come from, the operational system and the browser they use, the moment and the duration of the visit, which pages they visit, the age, the sex and the visitor interests).</p>	<p>Data collected via cookies is not linked to any identified or identifiable individual, and it is used mainly for statistical purposes that enable the owner to better adapt its website and to meet the visitor needs and wishes.</p>

External functions	<p>There are third party cookies located in the Website to improve its functioning (e.g. To use widgets of social networks, like Facebook, Twitter, etc., directly from the Website; to redirect him through social networks like Facebook and Instagram; or to know its geolocation to indicate where is the nearest distributor, if applicable).</p>	<p>Generally, these cookies are connected to the user's personal device or even to those personal data included in the user's social networks.</p> <p>The user has the possibility to decide whether he wants to use them (either explicit or implicit, requesting a specific service)</p>

1.3. HOW DO WE OBTAIN YOUR INFORMED CONSENT?

When you access to the Website for the first time, you will encounter a message prompting you to accept the functionality cookies, the analytical, or the external function ones. These cookies can only be installed if you accept their use.

The necessary cookies will be installed in your device when you access to the Website, they are needed for proper operation.

The message will include a link to the cookies policy for more information about how we treat cookies.

The banner will not appear again on the screen next time you visit the Website, but the option to delete the cookies will continue available in the web browser options (see the section 1.4.)

1.4. OBJECTION AND RIGHTS TO WHICH YOU ARE ENTITLED

We cannot change cookies settings on your browser, or disable the cookies already consented or necessary to browse on the Website. Nevertheless, you can change your browser setting to delete different types of cookies or to avoid the storing of cookies in the future at any moment. In the Help function of your browser you may find more details on how to manage your cookies setting in your own browser.
